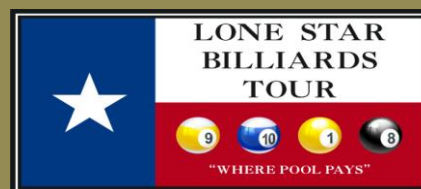

SINGLES BOARDS EXPLAINED

Question: What is a "board" and why do I want to play in one.

Answer: A singles board is like a mini tournament. Each board has 4 to 8 people who will compete down to one. The winner of the tournament will go to the regional event. At the regional event you will compete against up to 16 other players in your skill level bracket. The winner will go to Vegas in April to Compete for 25,000.00.

Question: What must I do to qualify?

Answer: You must have 10 scored matches in the event you tring to qualify in. 8 Ball, 9 Ball. You must remain on a team to remain qualified.

Question: Cost?

Answer: Each board should generate 120.00 So if there is 4 players it is \$30 a person if there is 8 people it is \$15.00. Because the APANHC likes to be consistant we will cover the shortfall on the boards so all APANHC members will only pay \$15.00 per played board.

Question: Where is the Regional Event.

Answer: The regional event was held at Bogies. The event could be held in Beaumont, Killeen, Houston, Austin San Antonio. The event is held where the most boards came from. The more boards we do the higher the chance the tournament will be held here. We won't know until after all the boards have been turned in.

Question: Who pays for the regional event?

Answer: You will need to pay your expences for the regional event. If it is local it will not be much. If it is out of town we will work with those who need help.

Question: Who pays for Vegas?

Answer: Upon arrival to Vegas you will receive \$ 200 to pay towards your flight. The APA will provide a room and a roommate.
