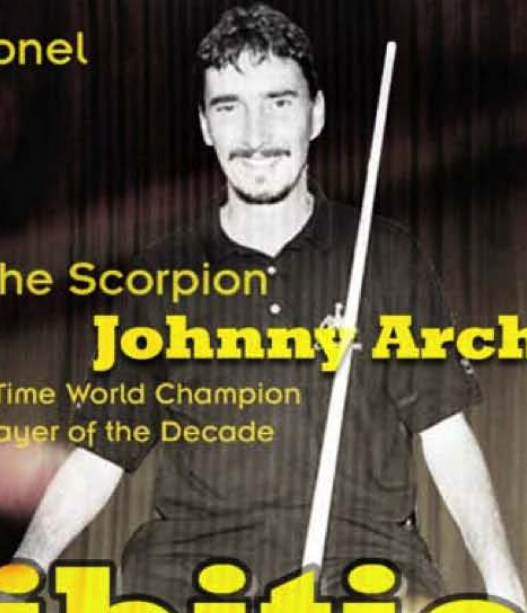

Trophies will be awarded to the first place team in each 8 ball division. At the end of each session the following teams will become qualified for the LTC championships.

4, 5 team division first place team

6, 8 team division first place team and the winner of a play off of the 2nd, 3rd, 4th place team and wild card team.

9-11 team division first and second place team as well as the winner of a playoff of the 3rd, 4th, 5th place team and a wild card team.

12-18 team division First, second, third place team as well as the winner of a playoff of the 4th, 5th, 6th place team and a wild card team.

9 Ball Divisions

Trophies will be awarded to the first place team in each Division. The first and second place teams will qualify for the LTC. Each division will also have at least one wild card team invited to the LTC.

All players playing in the LTC tournament must have 10 matches played prior to the end of the Spring Session. All established players must have a minimum of 4 matches played prior to playoffs. Any established players that have less than 10 current scores in the last year will have to play a minimum of 4 matches in the spring session.

Any team that does not stay in the top 50% of their Division will lose their eligibility and have to requalify. Exceptions will be made on a case by case basis. At the end of the Spring Session there will be a cash cup. Teams that did not qualify for the LTC will be given the opportunity to play in this tournament. The number of teams participating will determine the prize money. This Tournament will be played as an 8 Ball tournament and all 9 ball participants without an established 8 Ball skill level will play at their 9 Ball level.

Good luck to everyone next year. Just as a reminder we have a travel assistance program to help pay for the cost of the Vegas trip. This year we paid 3,300.00 to each Team. We will try and pay more next year but we need to continue to grow. Help us get more trips to Vegas. We need to grow the number of Teams. To get another 8 ball trip we need grow by 10 more Teams. In 9 Ball we need to grow 26 Teams to get a second trip. I appreciate all the help everyone can provide. The more we grow the more we can do. Thanks in advance for your continued support.
