Vegas! We had a great time this year. A lot of you say you would like to attend the tournament. There are many ways to attend. In April there is the singles Championship and the Jack & Jill event. To go in April you need to qualify to attend the next regional event. We hold "Qualifiers" when there are at least 4 players ready to play. The cost is \$15 per player and each player must have 10 matches in and be on a team in the format they play. If you win the board you will play in the regional event, win there and you will be in Vegas. With the Jack & Jill program you will need to play in a qualifier the cost of which is \$35. To be a team you must have a male and female player whose combined skill level does not exceed 10. Both players must have 20 matches played in 8 ball. After winning the qualifier you will play in a city tournament to compete for the trip to Vegas.

For the APANNHC to have a ladies team attend the national championships we would need 12 ladies teams to compete weekly. The ladies teams are like the open teams but ladies. Any one interested in starting a ladies team please call the office and we will see if there is enough interest. We would like to start a masters division in the Spring Session. If we

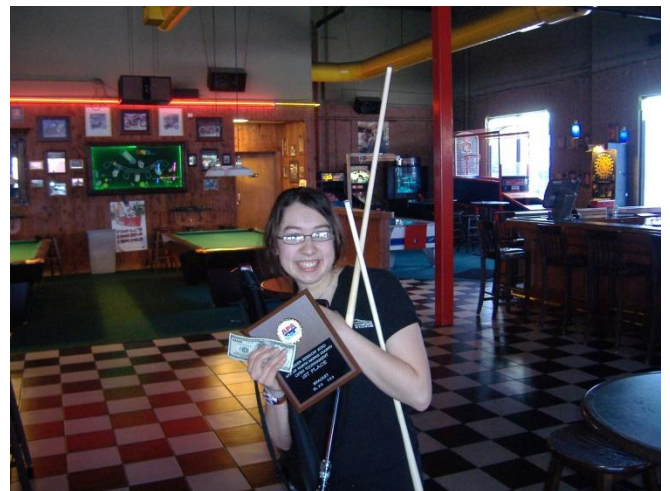

have a Division with at least 6 teams the winner of the session will represent the APANHC in Vegas in 2012.

In Vegas this year there were 5 teams DQed for different reasons. One team had a player that was impersonating someone else. One team was caught erasing the defensive shots from the other teams score sheet. The other teams were removed from the tournament for moving up in skill level. When this happens the team and players will not play in the APA for two years. Don't let this happen to you. Play your game locally and learn to mark defensive shots. Play pool and have fun.
